
Formative: tasks listed here are for practice and to give students an opportunity to learn while doing. Not every learning task is recorded in the gradebook. The tasks reflect student completion, growth, and/or achievement towards an outcome or goal.

- Students may receive a number indicating level of proficiency with the task,
- a ‘C’ denotes that the task was completed satisfactorily,
- an ‘INC’ indicates that the task was either incomplete or not meeting the expectation, or
- ‘ABS’ indicates that the student was absent during the task.
- A student may also have a blank or an ‘NA’ meaning that they may not have had to complete the task, or it will be assessed at a later time.

Summative: tasks listed here are used to determine levels of achievement at a specific point in time and are reported on the report card.

Grades and comments are subject to change as students complete, redo, and change tasks. Teachers strive to keep their gradebooks updated in a timely manner to facilitate effective communication.
